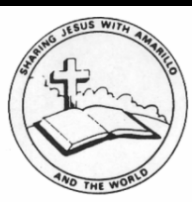

### **“On This Mountain”**

#### **Isaiah 25:6-12**

##### **Intro:**

Explanation of text.

Read 25:1-5

When the earth experiences God’s judgment, the world learns righteousness - 26:9

Read 25:6-12

Three times the expression “On this mountain” is found.

Vs. 6 - “A feast of rich food for all people.”

Vs. 7 - “He will swallow up death forever.”

Vs. 10 - “He will rest, provide and destroy.”

Brother and Sister we live on this mountain:

Heb. 12:18,22-23, 28

What will we receive if we come to Mt. Zion?

#### **First, we will receive perfect satisfaction - Vs. 6**

A. Eph. 1:3-5

1. James 4:3

B. If you seek God and His kingdom then all the provision that God ever intended for man to have is at your disposal, present for your use, and yours by right of living on the mountain of God.

#### **Second, the Lord will supply full salvation - Vs.7**

A. Jesus said that when a righteous man dies—he didn’t - John 11:25-26.

B. If we live with God on Mt. Zion, if we cling to the unshakeable kingdom on that unshakeable Mountain then there is no power on earth, nor in hell that can destroy us and none in heaven will.

**Third, there is total victory - Vs. 8**

- A. You know what victory brings don't you?
- B. John says that Jesus is our propitiation for our sins and for the world.
  - 1. I John 1:8-9
- C. We don't have to wait until heaven to have a tearless eye!
  - 1. Isa. 59:2
  - 2. Song "Blesses Assurance"--- Pg. 480
- D. Look at Vs. 9
  - 1. Then joy is ours.
