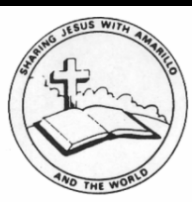

Thoughts from Leonard

IT CANNOT LIVE ALONE!

We read in **James 2:26**. "...*the body without the spirit is dead.*" So, from this reading we understand the passage of scripture found in **Ecclesiastes 12:7**, "*Then the dust (body) will return to the earth as it was, And the spirit will return to God who gave it.*"

The body is the animal frame of man which houses the spirit, the immortal nature. The composition of the flesh becomes an organism which, when united with the spirit, constitutes life. Our bodies we receive from our earthly parents; our spirits are infused into us, and fathered for us, by God, **Heb. 12:9**. The body is temporal, frail, and subject to deterioration and decay. As the earthly body, referred to as a "tent" in **2 Cor. 5:1** and **2 Pet. 1:13-14**, ceases to exist, then the soul becomes a resurrected body.

"The soul who sins shall die..." **Ezekiel 18:4**, therefore, sin stands as the cause, death is the effect. It certainly behooves each of us to live as close to the wishes of the Heavenly Father as we can, realizing that this life is short, just 70 years, **Psalms 90:10**. The apostle Paul very ably stated in **2Cor. 5:6-9**, "*Therefore we are always confident, knowing that while we are at home in the body we are absent from the Lord. For we walk by faith, not by sight. We are confident, yes, well pleased rather to be absent from the body and to be present with the Lord. Therefore we make it our aim, whether present or absent, to be well pleasing to Him.*"

What is Life? It is that state or condition which obtains while the body and spirit are united. What is death? It is the resulting condition when the spirit is no longer in the body. Death is then, simply the separation of body and spirit.

"And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die," **John 11:26**. "*Most assuredly, I say to you, if anyone keeps My word he shall never see death.*" The soul shall never die, it will live eternally...heaven or hell! We have a choice while the physical body lives. "...*the body without the spirit is dead.*"

"Work and plan like you are going to live forever; live every day like you will meet the Lord tomorrow!"
