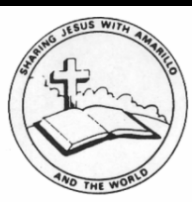

Dear Members of the San Jacinto church of Christ,

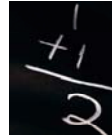
