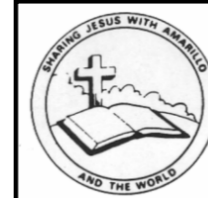

Remembering the good old days, back when I was a kid, I just loved to work with my dad. Whatever he was doing, I tried to be right in the middle of it. I'm sure there were times when he would have gotten the job done quicker and better if I hadn't been there for him to trip over, but he never seemed to mind at all. My favorite job was to hand him the tools. If he said, "Hand me the hammer" he didn't have to say, "Don't hand me a screwdriver or pliers."

When dad said, "Go get me a glass of water" he didn't have to say "Don't bring me a glass of milk and don't bring me a sandwich." I knew he wanted a glass of water! If he asked me to get him a leaf rake, he didn't have to tell me not to bring a shovel or a hoe. I just naturally knew what he wanted because he said it clearly. An eight-year-old boy could understand and obey.
