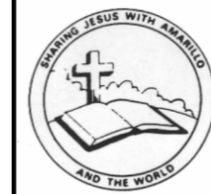

By the way, no one will run a credit check on you and you will not receive a monthly bill. All who apply for membership are hopelessly in debt. That’s why they want membership—because Jesus paid the penalty for them when He died on Calvary. Through Him their debt of sin can be forgiven!
