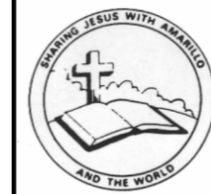

## “DO NOT BE DECEIVED”

The other day Sara received a phone call saying that the warranty on our car was about to expire. When the caller asked for the make and model of our car, Sara said, “If you don’t know that, this must not be a legitimate call.” The caller hung up.

*Caveat emptor* (let the buyer beware). If we must be alert to scams, how much more do we need to watch out for the one “*who deceives the whole world*” (Rev. 12:9). Jesus labels him “*a liar and the father of lies*” (John 8:44).

*“Do not be deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, not homosexuals, nor thieves, nor the covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers, will inherit the kingdom of God”* (1 Cor 6:9-10). Anyone who thinks these are not sins is deceived.

*“Do not be deceived: Bad company ruins good morals”* (1 Cor. 15:33). Anyone who thinks he will not be influenced is deceived.

*“Do not be deceived: God is not mocked, for whatever one sows, that will he also reap. For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption...”* (Gal. 6:7-8). Anyone who imagines that his sinful behavior will have no consequences is deceived.

*But each person is tempted when he is lured and enticed by his own desire. Then desire when it has conceived gives birth to sin, and sin when it is fully grown brings forth death. Do not be deceived, my beloved brothers”* (James 1:14-16). Anyone who does not see where sin ultimately leads is deceived.

Sin is deceitful ( Heb. 3:13). Eve let Satan talk her into sinning. Have we never fallen into the same trap?

How easy it is to convince ourselves that it’s OK under the circumstances, that no one will find out, that an exception will be made in my case, etc.

So we’ve been warned—repeatedly. If we still let ourselves be duped by the devil, who can we blame?
