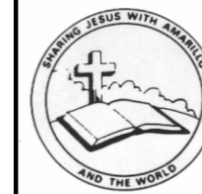

Dear Brother & Sisters,  
 I am appealing to you to take immediate action on a serious matter occurring in Texas. The State Board of Education is about to pass a requirement to teach children that evolution is fact. Should this happen, students will be banned from expressing curiosity about any weaknesses. And, if our children are programmed into a blind faith through our public schools, it undermines their belief in God's creation and they will begin to seriously question if the Bible is true, impacting their receptivity to Jesus Christ.

If you believe children should learn the scientific criticisms of (the theory of organic) evolution, we would like for you to join a group of concerned citizens—the Texans for Better Science Education. Its website has information you can use to help insure our textbooks are accurate and intellectually honest by presenting both weaknesses and strengths, as is currently required by Texas law.

**URGENT ACTION NEEDED**

We ask that you immediately announce this website to members of your congregation —www.strengthsandweaknesses.org —and encourage them to log on and at least sign the petition, taking no more than a few minutes of their time. There is also information that concerned members could use, if interested, such as email the specific board member for their district and/or call the board member's office to speak to him directly.

**WHY NOW? WHY ME?**

The second round of voting is March 25th, so urgent action is needed now before the measure is passed. At the moment, the board majority (8 votes) favors teaching evolution as fact with only seven votes favoring retaining weaknesses language. If it is decided to teach evolution as fact, this will continue for ten years and become very difficult to change. Of the eight voting to teach evolution as fact, three are GOP members. If you know people who reside in these districts, it would be helpful to encourage them to personally email or call them and stress that they vote to retain weaknesses. (While the general email address of SBOE-SUPPORT should forward messages to all board members, it is recommended that you email the board member directly and copy the general email address as a precaution.)
