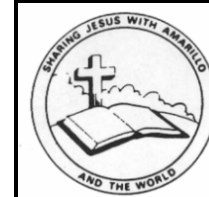

FACTS EACH MUST FACE

Life is short: *“Man that is born of woman is of few days, and full of trouble. He cometh forth like a flower, and is cut down”* (Job 14:1-2). *“What is your life? It is even a vapour, that appeareth for a little time, and then vanisheth away”* (James 4:14).

Death is certain: *“It is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment”* (Heb. 9:27). The strength of man’s mind and the wealth of the world have been spent from earliest times to find a way to escape the fate of death. Still, all die.

The conditions in obeying the gospel are (1) Believe on Jesus (Acts 16:31; John 8:24; Acts 8:36-37); (2) Repent (Acts 2:38; 17:30; Luke 13:3, 5); (3) Confess Christ (Matthew 10:32-33; Acts 8:36-38; Rom. 10:10); and (4) Be baptized (immersed) for the remission of sins (Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38; 22:16); (5) Live faithfully unto death (Rev. 2:10; Matt. 10:22; James 1:12).
