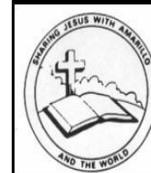

#### A CHOICE OR A CHILD?

EDITR'S NOTE: This article was written prior to Super Bowl.

When it comes to athletic competition, many people do not like Tim Tibow. He is multi-talented and played on a football team that won two national college championships in a four-year span. Those kinds of things are understandable in athletics. However, Tim Tebow is also disliked for his religious beliefs and values. Through the years, he has been ridiculed and mocked for his unabashed public displays of Bible verses and his stand on personal sexual purity. What has been so interesting, however, is that people could not dismiss him, because, in the first place, he has lived (as far as I can tell) in harmony with his beliefs. It is an impressive thing when someone lives a life that is consistent with his profession of faith. In the second place, Tim is such a gifted and extraordinary athlete that even those who don't like him must allow him his time in the spotlight. In a day and age when athletes show up in the court of law almost as often as they do on the court or field of play, it is difficult to hide one who lives morally and ethically.

All this brings me to a fact that many Americans did not know about Tim Tebow. A few weeks before he was to be born, Tim's mother contracted an amoebic infection and was extremely ill. She was advised by a doctor to abort the baby. She did not follow the doctor's advice, and gave birth to Tim.

That story is now being told more widely through a television ad produced by Focus on the Family (and costing about \$3.5 million) and that ad is scheduled to be aired during the Super Bowl, February 7, 2010. I say "scheduled" because CBS (the network set to televise the Super Bowl) is being harassed by various pro-abortion groups because of its plans to air the commercial. Abortion proponents give themselves away when a woman such as Tim's mother makes the choice not to abort, and they ridicule her for telling the story in a public medium. We will have to wait and see how this plays out.

Whether the commercial plays or not is beside the point. The fact remains that, in the discussion of abortion, the subject of every abortion is a baby, not a mere lump of fetal tissue. When an abortion is performed, human death occurs. It is not a coincidence that many, if not all, women who have had abortions later deal with grief and/or guilt over the death of the child.

The Law of Moses prohibited the sacrifice of children to gods (Deuteronomy 18:10). This act was called a despicable practice

(2 Kings 16:3). We may not have carved idols which are worshipped today, but abortion, as practiced in America and around the world, is equal to the sacrifice of children to the gods of convenience and pleasure.
